
**REACH Regulation (EG) no. 1907/2006
ECHA candidate list of the 27th of June 2018**

Dear customer,
as a pallet producer we are not a manufacturer or importer of chemical substances or preparations. However we have asked our suppliers to check their duties according to REACH, to register all chemical substances or preparations if required by REACH and to inform us immediately. INKA presswood pallets don't contain substances of the current candidate list > 0,1%.

INKA presswood pallets consist up to 85 % of the natural raw-material wood and approx. 15% binding agent. As a binding agent an aqueous urea-formaldehyde-condensation resin is used. As to its emission behaviour, the finished pallet corresponds to the E1-class (lowest emission class for particleboard).

INKA-pallets (moulded particle board pallets) do not exceed the limiting value of the concentration of the heavy metals Pb, Hg, Cd and Cr(VI) according of CEN/CR 13695-1:2000. At the manufacture of the pallet no materials are added which could release PCB, lindane or dioxins accord. to DIN EN 13428:2000. Thus it is guaranteed that no dangerous materials can separate from the pallets.
